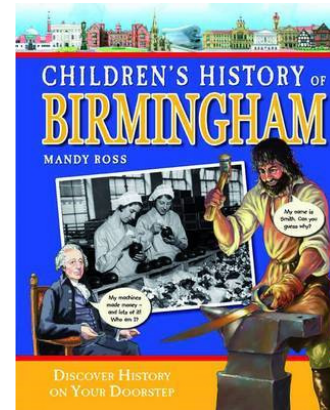


Write On! History writing workshops with local author Mandy Ross
